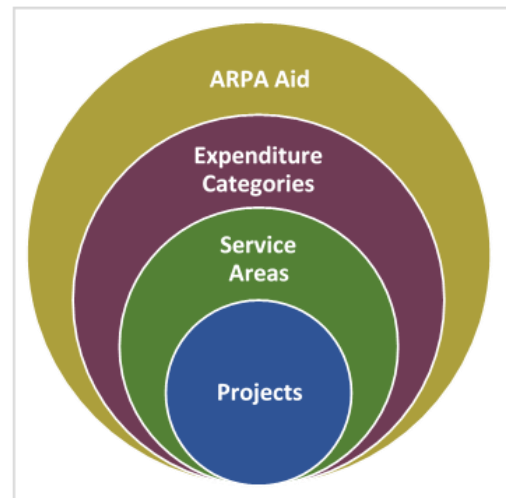
**BACKGROUND**

Milwaukee County will directly receive \$183 million between 2021-24 in federal ARPA aid. Approximately \$37 million has been allotted for Community Support projects.

The Community Support Service Area subgroup was established to generate project-level allocation recommendations to respond to economic harms to workers, families, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector in Milwaukee County.

The Other Social Determinants of Health subgroup was formed with subject matter experts following the Community Support Service Area Subgroup Charter. Membership includes the following individuals:

Girls Programming & Programming for Special Populations in Child, Youth and Family Services (CYFS) project	Girls Programming and Programming for Special Populations in CYFS will expand services for girls (including transgender youth who identify as girls) to counteract social isolation and other harmful effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, particularly African American girls who are disproportionately at risk, adjudicated, and placed out of home in the Milwaukee County youth justice system. Funds will support comprehensive, gender responsive services for girls including prevention and intervention services through new and growing partnerships with grassroots community-based organizations best positioned to serve these girls and address the root causes of behavioral problems; programming for girls in secure care; and expanded community-based alternatives to incarceration to prevent harmful placements.	\$2,950,000

Approve the recommendation for the Girls Programming and Programming for Special Populations in CYFS project to receive \$2,950,000 within the Community Support Expenditure Category.
