A. A report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), requesting approval to execute affordable housing development contracts in the amount of \$9,487,541 using previously approved American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds.

B. In 2022, the Milwaukee County Board allocated \$15 million of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for affordable housing under File 22-702. The contracts being recommended for a total of \$9,487,541 as a result of a Request for Proposals (RFP) process include Jewish Family Services, Inc. for \$2,000,000; MSP Real Estate, Inc. for \$2,487,541; Cornerstone Village – Wauwatosa, LLC for \$2,500,000; and Scott Crawford, Inc. and J. Jeffers & Co for \$2,500,000.

C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request.
