Section 56.30(9) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) requires that a written contract be signed and executed before an outside party performs professional services in an amount greater than \$2,000, while Section 56.30(8) of the Code states that the Comptroller shall deny payment for professional services if the conditions of Chapter 56 have not been met. The Department of Health and Human Services is requesting authorization to pay University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee \$5,521.28 for evaluation services performed prior to a contract being executed and is requesting a waiver of Sections 56.30(8) and (9) of the Milwaukee County Code of Ordinances.
- B. Expenditures included in this request total \$5,521.28.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request. Funding is provided by a carryover of unexpended Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) grant revenue which supports the annual contract of \$63,945.
