# Please share a success from the first half of 2024.

For the last six months I was able to serve 66 unduplicated client which is 145% of our goal, provided a total of 185 units of service which is 150% of our goal and reach out to 83 older refugees which is 115% of our goal

# Please share a challenge from the first half of 2024.

- There is one challenge that I have is to get older refugees other than Asian. I network with a few refugee service centers to let them know about the service we hardly get clients from them.
