



Help bring to life one of our signature community events! Returning for the third year, we and hundreds of volunteers will create a majestic field of flags at the War memorial Center. In 2021, we planted 7,057 flags to honor every brave United States service member who gave their life since 9/11.

As we celebrate the Medal of Honor throughout 2022, we will be placing 12,301 flags in honor of the Wisconsin service members who gave their life during the Civil War. This conflict marked both the birth of the Medal of Honor and Wisconsin's involvement in United States military action.




