SUBJECT: From the Director, Department of Transportation and the Interim President

and Managing Director, Milwaukee County Transit System, requesting approval to not implement the Transportation Network Companies (TNC) bus driver relief pilot program, as directed in the 2025 Adopted Budget for

Milwaukee County.

FILE TYPE: Action Item

#### **REQUEST**

The 2025 Adopted Budget includes an appropriation of \$35,000 to develop a pilot program offering driver relief rides through Transportation Network Companies that will provide a cost-effective operation for enhancing the safety and security of bus operators. The budget requested a progress report in April.

#### BACKGROUND

In June of 2024, the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) and ATU Local 998 agreed to implement a temporary van relief program for bus operators for enhanced safety and security. ATU Local 998 learned of a similar program operated by the Dallas Area Rapid Transit and wanted to test it in Milwaukee. The pilot program was to provide a total of two vans, one for each station, to pick up operators at scheduled relief points Monday through Friday until 6:00 p.m. after which remaining service terminates at the stations. Funding to cover pilot program expenses (operator wages, fuel, and maintenance) was made available within the existing budget for 2024 only. The two vans dedicated to the pilot program were borrowed from the training department.

Subsequently, the Adopted Budget for 2025 included the purchase of two additional vans for the pilot program but no operating funds were appropriated for the increased expenditures. The County Board also approved of a \$35,000 appropriation to purchase services from Transportation Network Companies (TNCs) as an alternative option.

## **UPDATE**

MCTS developed specifications for the procurement of TNC services to provide operator reliefs. Systemwide service includes 123 daily relief points, 58 at Fond du Lac Station (FDL) and 65 at Kinnickinnic Station (KK) for a weekly total of 615 rides. Each

TNC contacted through the bidding process charges \$10 per ride. If TNC service were provided at all relief points each week, the total cost would be \$6,150. Funding would be exhausted in less than six weeks into the pilot.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Given the costs of providing TNC's for driver relief rides, funding for the pilot program is estimated to be exhausted within six weeks of launch. Therefore, it is recommended that the pilot program not be implemented.
