- A. Approval of this resolution authorizes and directs the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture to change the name of Johnsons Park to Clarence and Cleopatra Johnson Park.
 - B. Approval of this resolution authorizes an appropriation transfer of \$9,750 from Agency 194, Org. Unit 1945 - Appropriation for Contingencies to an appropriate account in Org. Unit 9000 – Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture.
 - C. Approval of this resolution requires a one-time appropriation transfer of funds from contingency as monies were not allocated for this purpose in the Parks' current budget. Therefore, \$9,750 is allocated from Agency 194, Org. Unit 1945 - Appropriation for Contingencies to an appropriate account in Org. Unit 9000 - Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture. The Office of the Comptroller determined the balance of the Appropriation for Contingency account was \$4,078,985 for actions approved by the County Board through the July 2022 meeting cycle.

Assuming none of these contingency funds are spent, the Comptroller is projecting a year-end surplus/deficit of \$0 (break-even). This figure is likely to change as fiscal results are reported to the Office of the Comptroller each month. Use of funds from the Appropriation for Contingencies either decreases the County's overall surplus at year's end or increases its deficit. This resolution does not authorize or obligate further allocations beyond the funds authorized in this resolution.
