

**A RESOLUTION**

From the Chief Deputy, Office of the Sheriff, requesting an appropriation transfer of \$350,000 from Agency 194-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to Agency 400-4036 – Office of the Sheriff to increase the expenditure authority for the Allied Universal Security Services (AUS), (previously G4S Secure Solutions USA, Inc.) contract to provide secure transport services for the Milwaukee County Sheriff’s Office and an approval of an amendment to the current contract to raise the contract cap \$350,000 to \$3,106,959.

WHEREAS, AUS provides transportation services to and from the Criminal Justice Facility (“CJF”), Community Reintegration Center (“CRC”), Vel R. Phillips Youth Detention Center (“YDC”), other county jails and juvenile justice centers, State of Wisconsin correctional facilities and mental health facilities, medical facilities, federal correctional or detention facilities, and other locations as needed. AUS provides transportation Services to any of the seventy-two (72) counties located within the State of Wisconsin.; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2020 a request for proposals (RFP # 98200018) was issued by the Milwaukee County Sheriff’s Office to provide secured transportation services for the Sheriff with responses due on February 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, following selection of a proposal, the winning respondent, G4S Secure Solutions, indicated a request for a price increase which invalidated the award of RFP #98200018; and

WHEREAS, On or around April 6, 2021, AUS acquired G4S Secure Solutions (USA) Inc. and all obligations held by G4S Secure Solutions (USA) Inc. prior to acquisition, including the contract with Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, On September 27, 2023 the parties extended the contractual relationship on a month-to-month basis until the award and implementation of a new contract under a future RFP. This month-to month relationship was to end December 31, 2024.; and

WHEREAS, On December 20, 2024, the County issued RFP-2024-011: Intrastate Correctional Secure Transportation Management, seeking one or more providers of Secure Transportation services to provide intra-facility, inter-facility, and medical transports and/or scheduling, administration, and logistics services.; and

WHEREAS, In Amendment 7, MCSO agreed to adjust the Contractor’s pay and requirements for the Transportation Officer role to assist in the recruitment and retention

45 of qualified candidates to provide the Services, as well as to the staffing structure and  
46 overtime approval requirements to introduce more flexibility and transparency. There  
47 was a \$7 increase in the bill rates and an extension the contract period for no more than  
48 twelve (12) months to allow the Contractor to continue to provide Services until the  
49 award of the RFP and transition to the Awardee of the RFP is complete now; and,

51 WHEREAS, The total compensation to be paid to AUS for services shall be  
52 capped at \$2,756,959 for the 2025 year, unless agreed to by the County in writing; now,

55 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby supports  
56 and approves an appropriation transfer of \$350,000 from Agency 194-1945,  
57 Appropriation for Contingencies to Agency 400-4036 – Office of the Sheriff to provide  
58 secure transport services for the Milwaukee County Office of the Sheriff in accordance  
59 with state and federal laws, MCSO rules and regulations and Wisconsin Department of  
60 Justice (DOJ) standards; and

62 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors  
63 authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance, in coordination with the  
64 Office of the Comptroller, to transfer \$350,000 from Agency 194-1945 – Appropriation  
65 for Contingencies to the appropriate accounts in Agency 400-4036– Office of the Sheriff  
66 to provide secure transport services for the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office; and

68 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors  
69 authorizes the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office in coordination with Procurement to  
70 raise the current contract cap \$350,000 to \$3,106,959; and

72 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors  
73 requests that if any grants or other external funding sources are received for the  
74 increased in cost to provide secure transport services for the Milwaukee County  
75 Sheriff's office, any unused funds be returned to the Appropriation for Contingencies  
76 account.
