The Director and Chief Information Officer of Information Management Services Division, Department of Administrative Services (DAS-IMSD) is requesting authorization to abolish 1.0 FTE Database Administrator position and create 1.0 FTE career ladder Cloud Platform Administrator / Sr. Cloud Platform Administrator position. BACKGROUND

Over the last two years the Enterprise Data Services (EDS) team has migrated their work to the Microsoft Azure cloud computing environment, which requires a different skillset than the existing Database Administrator role. The recent departure of the team's Database Administrator presents the opportunity to align the vacant role to the new and future needs of the team.

The Cloud Platform Administrator / Sr. Cloud Platform Administrator on the Enterprise Data Services team will manage and optimize our Microsoft cloud-based data platform, with a strong focus on cloud-based data analytics technologies and associated reliability, infrastructure, and security.

ALIGNMENT TO STRATEGIC PLAN

The creation of the Cloud Platform Administrator / Sr. Cloud Platform Administrator position will support the Department of Administrative Services – Information Management Services Division's alignment to the strategic plan areas:
