- 0906: Housing Unit 4D makes an all-call for an inmate actively self-harming. SQ 315 in route. Inmate [REDACTED] (BK# [REDACTED], M/B, DOB [REDACTED]) was scratching his arm with a piece of metal. [REDACTED] was placed on suicide watch and returned to his cell.
- 0911: Housing Unit 3C makes an all-call for an inmate complaining of difficulty breathing. SQ 315 in route. Inmate [REDACTED] (BK# [REDACTED], M/W, DOB 0 [REDACTED]) was medically assessed and cleared to remain in the housing unit.
- 1005: Housing Unit 3B makes an all-call for a suicidal inmate. SQ 315 in route. Inmate [REDACTED] (BK# [REDACTED], M/B, DOB [REDACTED]) spoke with a PSW and was placed on suicide watch. He was secured and escorted to Housing Unit 4D where he was placed on the bench until a cell could open up.

The MHU staff was notified that he is not to have a suicide watch blanket.

She was then escorted to 4D, Sub Pod A cell 1, where she complied with the changeover process into a suicide gown and was secured in cell 1 without further incident.
- 0240: Notified by Sgt. Scott, at the airport, that patrol initiated a Hospital Watch at Froedtert Hospital, Room: [REDACTED], [REDACTED] (M/W, DOB 0[REDACTED]6. Officer KC Smith is enroute to Froedtert Hospital with occupant clothing and a hospital kit.
- 0320: Occupant [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (M/B, DOB [REDACTED], Booking Number [REDACTED]) returned from St. Luke's Hospital and was medically accepted. He returned to Pod 6B, cell [REDACTED].
