- A. WE Energies is requesting an easement to attach an electric service to an existing WE Energies pole located at the east property line of Kosziuszko Park at W. Grant Avenue, to install the infrastructure to provide electric service to a gas regulation pit at W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street and W. Lincoln Avenue.
- B. Revenue of \$830 will be realized based on \$1.60 per square foot for a 520 square foot easement. Staff time will be required for review of the Right of Entry application, but this review time will be compensated by the application fee.
- C. The revenue for the easement will help meet revenue targets for the budget year.
