

3 2026 One-year Professional Service Agreement with Core Linen Services, Inc., by
4 recommending adoption of the following:

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6 **A RESOLUTION**
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8 WHEREAS, the Community Reintegration Center (CRC) seeks to establish a
9 Professional Services Agreement (the Agreement) with Core Linen Services, Inc.
10 (Core), a qualified laundry services provider, to ensure uninterrupted access to clean
11 laundry for residents of the CRC, the Criminal Justice Facility (CJF), and Vel R. Phillips
12 Youth Detention Center (YDC); and

13 WHEREAS, this standby arrangement will be activated only if the CRC laundry
14 facility becomes inoperable due to mechanical failure, staffing shortages, public health
15 emergencies, or other unforeseen circumstances; and

16 WHEREAS, although YDC is included under this Agreement, it will operate under
17 a separate account and shall not be processed together with the CRC or CJF laundry
18 services under this Agreement; and

19 WHEREAS, this Agreement will only be activated upon written or electronic
20 notice from CRC Administration, or its designee, and may apply to partial or full laundry
21 needs depending on the severity of the disruption; and

22 WHEREAS, the vendor shall be prepared to initiate services within 24 hours of
23 receiving notice; and

24 WHEREAS, pricing is established at sixty-five cents per pound for washing and
25 drying services; and

26 WHEREAS, Core has agreed to the terms of a new Agreement, beginning
27 December 1, 2025, through November 30, 2026, contingent upon mutual agreement
28 and satisfactory performance; and

29 WHEREAS, thereafter, the Parties may mutually agree in writing to renew the
30 Agreement on an annual basis, with each renewal period not-to-exceed one year,
31 provided that total compensation for any single term does not exceed the approval
32 threshold established by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for professional
33 services contracts; and

34 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and General
35 Services considered File No. 25-727 for informational purposes only, per section
36 59.52(31)(d), Wisconsin State Statutes; and

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46 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 11, 2025,
47 recommended adoption of File No. 25-727 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,
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49 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
50 authorizes the Superintendent, Community Reintegration Center, to enter into a
51 Professional Services Agreement (the Agreement) with Core Linen Services, Inc.,
52 beginning December 1, 2025, through November 30, 2026, contingent upon mutual
53 agreement and satisfactory performance; and
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55 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the aforementioned Agreement will only be
56 executed after review and approval by the Office of Economic Inclusion, Department of
57 Administrative Services (DAS), the Office of Corporation Counsel, and Risk
58 Management, DAS.
