 - A. Approval of the requested action to amend Chapter 71 Section 71.30 to change the speed limit from forty (40) miles per hour to thirty-five (35) miles per hour on South 13th Street (CTH V) from W. College Ave. (CTH ZZ) to W. Puetz Rd.
 - B. Cost of signs and installation is estimated to be \$1,600 for the segment between W. College Ave. and W. Drexel Ave. This expenditure will be a one-time charge to the 2024 Highway Maintenance Operation Budget. Cost of signs and installation is estimated to be \$2,500 for the segment between W. Drexel Ave. and W. Puetz Rd. This expenditure will be charged to WisDOT Project ID 2505-03-71 / MCDOT Project ID WH0010222.
 - C. The work between W. Drexel Ave. and W. College Ave. (CTH ZZ) will be performed utilizing the 2024 Operation Budget which will have sufficient funds therefore this action will have no budgetary impact. The work between W. Puetz Rd. and W. Drexel Ave. will be performed utilizing funds from WisDOT Project ID 2505-03-71 / MCDOT Project ID WH0010222 which will have sufficient funds therefore this action will have no budgetary impact.
