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Background

- Conveyed need for monetary incentives via File #: 24-108 Informational Report
- Passage of File #: 24-268 Resolution allocated, '\$356,355 from Agency 194-1945
 Appropriation for Contingencies to Agency 800 Department of Health and
 Human Services to create the "Landlord Incentives to Foster Tenancy" (LIFT) pilot
 program to help grow the number of Milwaukee County landlords accepting tenant
 applicants receiving Milwaukee County rent assistance program funds'
 - Also required presentation of recommendations for, "sound processes and eligibility criteria for landlords to apply for Landlord Incentives to Foster Tenancy (LIFT) pilot program funds...by the June 85 2024 cycle or sooner."

COUNTY

- Pilot program launching in 2024 by Housing Services
- Provides monetary incentives for damage relief, if necessary, to support and encourage property owners to reduce screening criteria

Participants & beneficiaries

- Property partners: owners, managers, leasing agents, or realtors
- LIFT Administrators
- Tenants



Membership Benefits

- Monetary incentive up to 3x contract rent
 - Verified damage
 - Verified vacancy loss
- Tenant access to wraparound services
- Landlord access to ongoing administrative support
- Housing-ready tenants supported by Milwaukee County Housing Services' rent assistance programs

- Milwaukee County Housing Services rent assistance participants:
 - Continuum of Care (homeless) rent assistance
 - Housing Choice Voucher recipients (i.e. Section 8)




Membership Agreement
