10 AN ORDINANCE

13 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as
14 follows:

15 **SECTION 1.** Section 1. Section 17.33 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee
16 County is hereby amended as follows:

18 1) Seminar reimbursement of ~~six hundred dollars (\$600.00) effective January 1,~~
19 2006 seven hundred dollars \$700 effective January 1, 2011, per year per
20 employee to be used for the payment of registration fees or other reasonable
21 and necessary expenses for courses approved by the Continuing Legal
22 Education (CLE) Board and related to the employee's work and taken in the
23 current year or the preceding year. Any unused funds may be carried over for
24 use in the subsequent year. Any unused portion of the amount contributed
25 annually to each employee's CLE account by the County may be used by the
26 employee for the payment of the costs of periodicals and other publications or
27 payment toward professional association dues related to the employee's work.
28 Subject to budgetary constraints, the Chief Judge, Corporation Counsel,
29 Director of Child Support Enforcement Office, and the District Attorney may
30 approve expenditures in excess of the limits set forth herein, if deemed
31 necessary to meet the needs of their respective offices for specialized legal
32 advice or counsel. Should management exercise discretion to purchase an
33 Ultimate Pass product through the State Bar of Wisconsin, the cost of the
34 product will reduce the seminar reimbursement amount available to any
35 affected employee.

37 2) Reimbursement of one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the minimum
38 required mandatory membership dues in the Wisconsin Bar Association per
39 year per employee effective January 1, ~~2006~~2011. This one hundred percent
40 (100%) reimbursement will include the special assessments that are included
41 in the annual dues statement from the Wisconsin Bar Association.

43 **SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
