- A. The Executive Zoo Director is requesting to abolish one position of Facilities Grounds Worker and create one position of Mechanical Maintenance Grounds Worker to provide additional mechanical support and operational quality and quantity for the Zoo Grounds section of the Facilities Division, which is a seven-day-a-week operation that heavily uses small engine and mechanical equipment and machinery.
- B. The cost of the new Mechanical Maintenance Grounds Worker position is almost completely covered by eliminating one Facilities Grounds Worker position. The maximum salary impact on the Zoo's budget from creating a Mechanical Maintenance Grounds Worker position and eliminating the Facilities Grounds Worker role is \$9,981. However, due to the overlap between the two pay ranges, the actual fiscal impact could result in a net-zero tax levy change, depending on the starting salary of the new position.
- C. The position action is requested for the June County Board cycle with an effective date of July 6. The annual salary range for the Mechanical Maintenance Worker Grounds is \$41,509 \$62,285 and the vacant Facilities Grounds Worker position that will be abolished has an annual salary pay range of \$34,870 \$52,304. Any net fiscal impact will be absorbed within the Facilities Grounds, Horticulture and Forestry section.
