From the Chief Human Resources Officer, Department of Human Resources, Requesting an Increase in the Constitutional Office of the Sheriff Salary, in Accordance with Milwaukee County Ordinance Section 17.98 for the Next Eligible Term, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Section 17.98 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances outlines the process by which Milwaukee County can adjust the salary of certain elected officials, in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources (DHR) reviewed the salary for the position of Milwaukee County Sheriff, and since the current salary for this position is lower than some comparable counties, DHR is recommending the salary for this elected position to increase by 15 percent over the four-year term of office, effective the first day of the new term after the general election in 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of March 3, 2026, recommended adoption of File No. 26-332 (vote 2-1); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the recommended salary amounts for the position of Sheriff, effective the first day of the applicable new term after the applicable general elections held in 2026, as shown in the table below:
