 - A. The Department of Administrative Services, Information Management Services Division is requesting the abolishment of 1.0 FTE Manager Network (Pay Grade NR32E) and the creation of 1.0 FTE Supervisor Infrastructure Services (Pay Grade NR28). The Manager Network position was recently vacated. To align DAS-IMSD's organizational design with current departmental technology needs, the Connectivity and Telecom team will report to the Senior Infrastructure Manager. This requires abolishing the Manager Network position (1.0 FTE) and creating a Supervisor Infrastructure Services position (1.0 FTE). Supervisor Infrastructure Services position is responsible for effectively analyzing, planning, organizing, and leading teams in support of Infrastructure services while working closely with Senior Infrastructure Manager to manage risk, workload, scope, capacity, schedule, and budget.
 - B. Position actions result in an estimated reduction in personnel expenditures as the position costs (salary and social security) of the Supervisor Infrastructure Services are less than the Manager Network position. Please see the table on page 1 for the net personnel expenditure impact for 2025 and subsequent year if we hire a candidate at \$101,885.
