From the District Attorney, Office of the District Attorney, requesting authorization to create 1.0 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Victim/Witness Advocate position (title code 84171, pay grade 16Z6) in the Violent Crimes Unit, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Justice notified the Milwaukee County District Attorney’s Office of a grant award identified as Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Eastern District 2018-PE-01-15399, in the amount of \$316,576; and

WHEREAS, the award included compensation for a Victim/Witness Advocate for a period of approximately two years; and

WHEREAS, the PSN Grant funds 100 percent of project expenses without a local match requirement; and

WHEREAS, no appropriation of funds will be required for the creation of the new PSN position, which will be filled in Pay Period 2 of 2020 at the earliest; and

WHEREAS, budgetary authority for the 2020 portion of the project expenditures and offsetting revenue for the PSN Grant was included in the District Attorney’s 2020 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of December 12, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-841 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and approves the creation of one grant funded full-time equivalent Victim/Witness Advocate in the District Attorney’s Office, effective at the start of 2020, Pay Period 2, on December 30, 2019:
