A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Department of Administrative Services – Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget (DAS-PSB) work in conjunction with the Office of the Comptroller to develop an informational report on the ongoing fiscal impact of the expenditure limit promulgated in 2013 Wisconsin Act 14 on County Board operations and the ability of the Board of Supervisors to carry out its legislative duties

WHEREAS, 2013 Wisconsin Act 14 ("Act 14"), enacted May 31, 2013, made sweeping changes to the governance model of Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, the state legislation, in general, reduced the authority of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors and increased the authority of the Milwaukee County Executive; and

WHEREAS, one of the components of Act 14 imposed a strict limit on County Board expenditures to a maximum of 0.4 percent of the total tax levy with limited exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure limit has made it increasingly difficult to absorb even modest raises for County Board staff that were provided to all general County employees without reducing other budget costs including staff and/or resources to allow elected officials to communicate with constituents; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure limit formula, which is only applied to one County and one Department in the State of Wisconsin, is likely to result in more difficult decisions in future budgets that may compromise the County Board's ability to carry out its legislative duties; and

WHEREAS, an informational report on the ongoing fiscal impact the stateimposed expenditure limit may have on future County Board departmental budgets would be helpful to educate policymakers and the public on the impact it may have on future operations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Department of Administrative Services – Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget (DAS-PSB), working in conjunction with the Office of the Comptroller, is requested to develop an informational report on the ongoing fiscal impact of the expenditure limit on County Board operations as promulgated in 2013 Wisconsin Act 14; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the informational report is requested to be provided to the County Board for consideration no later than the September 2020 cycle so that policymakers and the public can better understand the fiscal constraints the expenditure limit may have on future legislative branch budgets and the ability of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors to carry out its legislative duties.
