3 From the Chief Judge, requesting authorization to accept the John D. and Catherine T.  
4 MacArthur Foundation Safety and Justice Challenge Capstone Grant (#22-2004-  
5 154606-CJ) award of \$570,000 from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025, by  
6 recommending adoption of the following:

8 **A RESOLUTION**

10 WHEREAS, the Safety and Justice Challenge is a competitive grant process to  
11 address communities' use of incarceration; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors  
14 (County Board) authorized the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court  
15 Operations, to accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase I Planning Grant from the  
16 John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation (MacArthur Foundation) (#108430) for  
17 the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase I (Adopted File No. 15-412); and  
18

19 WHEREAS, on May 26, 2016, the County Board authorized the Chief Judge to  
20 accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase II Implementation Grant from the  
21 MacArthur Foundation (#16-1601-150542-CJ) (Adopted File No. 16-271); and  
22

23 WHEREAS, on February 7, 2019, the County Board authorized the Chief Judge  
24 to accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase III Implementation and Community  
25 Engagement Grant from the MacArthur Foundation (#151955) (Adopted File No. 19-73);  
26 and

28 WHEREAS, on February 4, 2021, the County Board authorized the Chief Judge  
29 to accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase IV Sustainability Grant from the  
30 MacArthur Foundation (#20-1907-154112-CJ) (Adopted File No. 21-77); and

32 WHEREAS, on October 11, 2022, Milwaukee County submitted a Safety and  
33 Justice Challenge Capstone Grant to the MacArthur Foundation, for strategic planning,  
34 community engagement, racial and ethnic disparities work, and to memorialize the  
35 efforts of the Safety and Justice Challenge; and  
36

37 WHEREAS, the Capstone Application (the Application) included funding for the  
38 Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager position through the Wisconsin Policy  
39 Forum, Inc., in the amount of \$182,046, for the period of January 1, 2023, to  
40 December 31, 2025; and  
41

42 WHEREAS, the Application included funding for the Domestic Violence Deferred  
43 Prosecution Program through the Alma Center, Inc., in the amount of \$106,966, for the  
44 period of January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2023; and  
45

46 WHEREAS, the Application included funding for Wisconsin Circuit Court Access  
47 Representational State Transfer Interfaces and Tableau Licenses for DataShare  
48 through the Medical College of Wisconsin in the amount of \$14,120, for the period of  
49 January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2025; and

51 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 16, 2023,  
52 recommended adoption of File No. 23-339 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

54 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby  
55 authorizes the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations,  
56 to accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Capstone Grant in the amount of \$570,000,  
57 for the period of January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2025; and

59 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance  
60 (OSBP), and the Office of the Comptroller (Comptroller), are authorized and directed to  
61 process an administrative appropriation transfer to recognize \$570,000 in John D. and  
62 Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation (MacArthur Foundation) grant dollars, and to  
63 allocate funds to the appropriate departments accounts to provide for the programs  
64 described herein; and

66 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, OSBP, and the Comptroller, as part of the  
67 \$570,000 appropriation transfer, are authorized to recognize \$182,046 in MacArthur  
68 Foundation grant dollars, to contract with the Wisconsin Policy Forum, Inc., to provide  
69 the Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager position for the programs described  
70 herein; and

72 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, OSBP, and the Comptroller, as part of the  
73 \$570,000 appropriation transfer, are authorized to recognize \$106,966 in MacArthur  
74 Foundation grant dollars, to contract with the Alma Center, Inc., to provide the Domestic  
75 Violence Deferred Prosecution Program for the programs described herein; and

77 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, OSBP, and the Comptroller, as part of the  
78 \$570,000 appropriation transfer, are authorized to recognize \$14,120 in MacArthur  
79 Foundation grant dollars, to contract with the Medical College of Wisconsin for  
80 Wisconsin Circuit Court Access Representational State Transfer Interfaces and Tableau  
81 Licenses for DataShare, to provide for the programs described herein.
