41 WHEREAS, the level of requirements is divided into two Tiers, to be determined 42 for each project based on the cost and scope, as detailed in the Sustainable Design 43 Standards; and 44 45 WHEREAS, to prevent any undue burden that may affect the completion and 46 viability of certain projects, certain exemptions have been outlined in the Sustainable 47 Design Standards as well as an exemption process that can be pursued during the Pre-48 Design stage; and 49 50 WHEREAS, it has been shown that adhering to sustainability standards can 51 result in significant cost savings, such as the current upgrades of LED fixtures that will 52 result in an estimated 30% reduction in energy costs for Milwaukee County; and, 53 54 WHEREAS, the Sustainable Design Standards institutionalizes Milwaukee 55 County's commitment to environmental stewardship, equity, and resilience by promoting 56 strategies such as energy efficiency, emissions reduction, and adaptive infrastructure; 57 and 58 59 WHEREAS, the Committee on Community, Environment, and Economic 60 Development, at its meeting of May 12, 2025, recommended adoption of 61 File No. 25-315 (vote 5-0); now, therefore, 62 63 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors supports the 64 Office of Sustainability's Sustainable Design Standards, as hereto attached to this file, 65 by incorporating equity-focused, energy-efficient, and climate-resilient practices into the 66 planning, design, and construction of County-owned facilities; and 67 68 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 69 strongly encourages the inclusion of the Office of Sustainability's Sustainable Design 70 Standards for consideration in all relevant construction project requests for bids and 71 proposals; and 72 73 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 74 supports all relevant projects meeting applicable minimum mandatory requirements as
