

Potential Federal Government Shutdown Impacts (2/1)

<u>Department</u>	<u>Potential Issue</u>	<u>Potential Fiscal Impact</u>
BHD	TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) funding goes from Federal to State. If State loses funding they may stop funding local governments	\$4.8M unpaid or delayed
DHHS - Housing	Section 8 Housing funding expires in February. Full reimbursement is expected, but landlords may be expected to cover delayed funding	tbd
Courts	Revenue related to Child Support services	\$200k / month
Pre-Trial Services	Expenditures related to federal grants	\$77k
Child Support	Child Support is funded through September 30. No impacts unless the shutdown lasts through October	tbd
Emergency Management	National Weather Service only providing essential services. NWS staff is unable to aid in proactive planning efforts.	tbd
Emergency Management	FEMA / Wisconsin Healthcare Emergency Readiness grants delayed	\$577k
Emergency Management	FEMA training is postponed and certificate processing is unavailable	tbd
Emergency Management	Wireless Emergency Alert authorization is delayed	tbd
Emergency Management	Overdose Detection Mapping tool is unavailable. Tool allows a rapid public health response to opioid issues	tbd
Parks	Natural areas and coastal management grants delayed	\$2.1M
Parks	Inability to apply for additional grants	tbd
