

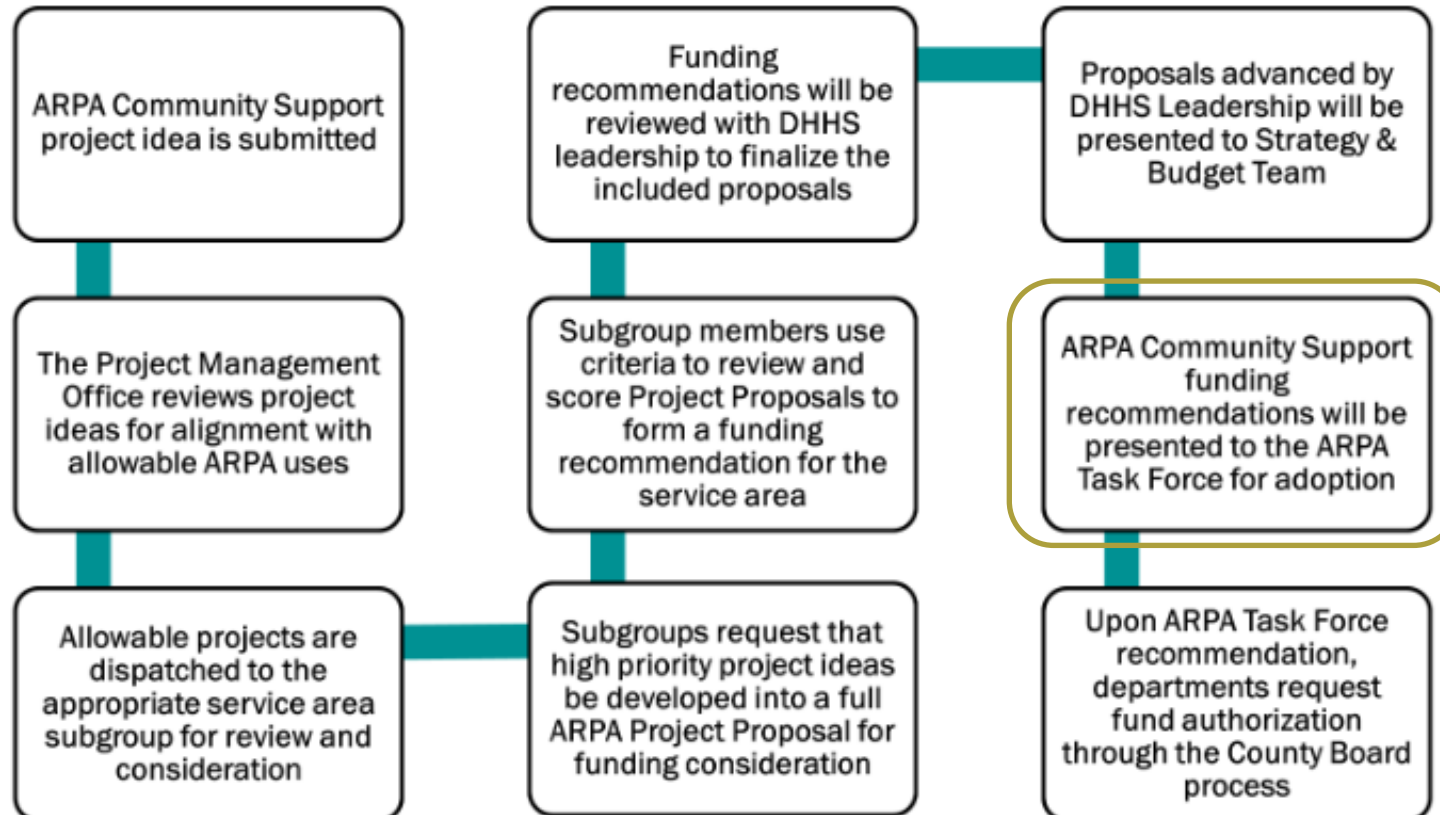

Community Support Project Pipeline



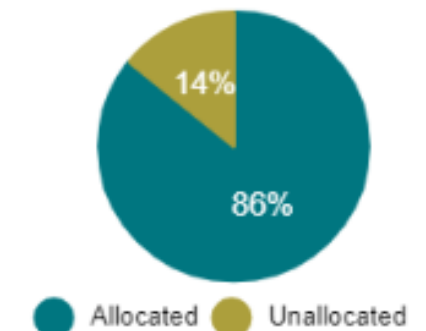
