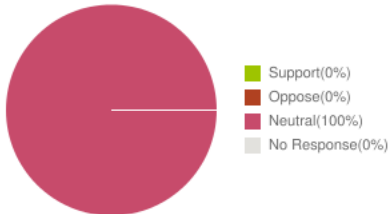

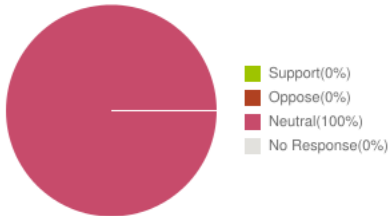

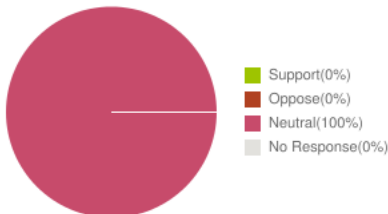
Overall Sentiment
