- A. The Department of Health and Human Services is seeking approval to transfer \$2,000,000 in funding designated for affordable housing development in its 2024 Adopted Budget. Approval of this request will allow infrastructure improvement work to continue under capital project WS0156011-Oak Creek Housing Development to include utility work, road construction, and other site work to allow for the eventual building of affordable single-family homes.
- B. This transfer would increase the total budget for capital project WS0156011 by \$2,000,000. The original budget established for this capital project is \$5 million authorized by File 24-472 adopted in May 2024.
- C. Through the 2024 Milwaukee County budget process, the County Board authorized \$4 million for the development of additional affordable housing units. Of this amount, \$2 million was allocated to the Concordia 27 Project located in the Near West Side neighborhood. Housing Services is requesting that the remaining \$2 million be placed in capital project WS0156011-Oak Creek Housing Development to increase the total budget for the infrastructure development to \$7 million.
