10 AN ORDINANCE

13 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as  
14 follows:

15 **SECTION 1.** 20.01. Cost of maintaining prisoners at county jail and house of correction.

16  
17 The cost of maintenance for prisoners confined in county jail or the house of correction  
18 for violation of city or village ordinances, resolutions or bylaws is hereby fixed at the per  
19 diem cost of each establishment as determined by the county department of  
20 administration on April 1 of each year and based upon out of pocket expenses of the  
21 preceding calendar year for each separate institution. The sheriff and superintendent of  
22 the house of correction, respectively, shall at regular intervals bill cities and villages for  
23 the above maintenance charges of their prisoners, and shall specify therein such data  
24 as may reasonably be required for such purposes.

26 Each prisoner listed in s. 303.08(4), Wis. Stats. is liable for charges in an amount of  
27 twenty-four dollars (\$24.00) per day, which represents the cost of his/her board in the  
28 jail or house of correction if confined pursuant to s. 303.08, Wis. Stats., Huber Law or s.  
29 973.09(4), Wis. Stats., conditions of probation. In addition, those inmates on electronic  
30 surveillance shall be charged a rate of twenty four dollars (\$24.00) per day. The  
31 ~~superintendent of the house of correction~~ Sheriff is authorized to accept credit cards for  
32 the payment of board provided that any charges imposed by the credit card firm are  
33 added to the daily board rate. In addition, the ~~superintendent of the house of correction~~  
34 Sheriff is authorized to impose a reasonable charge, not to exceed costs, for random  
35 urine tests for controlled substances, which result in a positive finding. And if the result  
36 of the random test is positive, the ~~superintendent~~ Sheriff may impose a reasonable  
37 charge, not to exceed the cost for regular follow-up urine tests for all controlled  
38 substances. The county department of administration on April 1 of each year shall  
39 render a report to the county board detailing the costs of maintenance and board  
40 experienced for the preceding calendar year. The sheriff and superintendent of the  
41 house of correction shall charge the account of each prisoner gainfully employed  
42 accordingly and shall collect and disburse to the county treasurer all such proceeds  
43 from the wages or salaries of employed prisoners. In addition, each inmate shall pay a  
44 set-up and equipment fee of \$50 for GPS and voice print installation and assessment  
45 and \$110 for SCRAM installation and assessment. Unemployed home detention  
46 inmates shall pay equipment costs per day of the following: \$1.25 per day for each

47 inmate on voice print, \$5.00 per day for each inmate on GPS and \$8.25 per day for  
48 each inmate on SCRAM.

50 **SECTION 4.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and  
51 publication.
