SUBJECT: Request by the Sheriff to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors to execute a purchase of services contract to provide limited, contracted civil process service within Milwaukee County from March 19, 2017 and not to exceed August 31, 2017 until a new contract is awarded based upon the current RFP, whichever comes first and request the provision of Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances Section 56.30(9) is waived and the Comptroller is authorized to pay for any services rendered by State Process Services, Inc. prior to the contract being signed and executed.

The Sheriff is requesting to execute a purchase of services contract to continue to provide civil process paper service within Milwaukee County at the previously established rate of \$34 per service attempt. The Sheriff is requesting a contract from March 19, 2017 and not to exceed August 31, 2017. The contract will be terminated prior to the expiration date upon 14 days written notification when a new contract is awarded from the results of the RFP. This resolution also waives provisions of Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances Section 56.30(9) and authorizes the Comptroller to pay for any services rendered by State Process Services, Inc., prior to the contract being signed and executed. The adoption of this resolution will not require the expenditure of any County tax levy not previously authorized in the 2017 Adopted Budget.
