

Court Coordinator Eviction Diversion Grant, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) Combined Court Related Operations has convened the Housing Consortium (HC) for approximately two years to improve the handling of evictions in Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, the HC is composed of judges, commissioners, and clerks from the court system, landlord representatives, legal services, rental assistance, and local funding partners; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Courts and Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations, applied for and received a grant from the National Center for State Courts (NCSC) to fund a Court Coordinator (Eviction Diversion) to facilitate continued progress toward improving the eviction process, and increase housing stability in Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, the Eviction Diversion Grant is for a two-year period, for a total of \$181,098, with the potential for additional funding in the third and fourth years of the program; and

WHEREAS, included in the request was funding for one, Full-Time Equivalent, Court Coordinator position; and

WHEREAS the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of June 16, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-753 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby authorizes and approves the following position action for Combined Court Related Operations, effective the start of the first pay period after approval (June 1, 2022):
