From the Chief Deputy, Office of the Sheriff, requesting to retroactively amend and extend an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with Racine County from December 31, 2022, to December 31, 2023, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 66.0301 and 302.44 for the temporary housing of certain jail occupants, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County), as represented by its Director, Detention Operations Commander, Milwaukee County Jail (MCJ), has a need to transfer occupants of the MCJ (the Transferees) to an alternate facility to open up space within the MCJ for population management purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 66.0301 and Section 302.44, Wisconsin State Statutes, permits the County and Racine County to enter into agreements for the cooperative establishment and use of jails, for the detention and imprisonment of the Transferees before, during, and after trial, and for apportioning expenses; and

WHEREAS, the County and Racine County entered into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (ICA) for temporary housing of certain MCJ occupants starting in July 2022, and ending December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the daily rate charged by Racine County is \$70 (the Daily Fee) for each Transferee housed at the Racine County Jail, including partial days; and

WHEREAS, daily Fees and any other costs owed by the County hereunder will be invoiced to the County monthly, and will be due within 30 days after receipt of such invoice, and any documentation reasonably necessary, for the County to validate the charges; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the ICA extends the agreement from December 31, 2022, to December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 26, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-248 (vote 4-3); and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and General Services, at its meeting of January 30, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-248 (vote 3-2); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chief Deputy, Milwaukee County Sheriff’s Office, to amend and extend the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with Racine County, for the temporary housing of certain Milwaukee County Jail occupants, for the period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023.
