## **REQUEST**

## POLICY

The 2024 Adopted Budget authorized and requested ASD to develop a scope of work for an external audit of the Milwaukee County Jail that focuses on operations, policies, and procedures to ensure procedural best practices are being followed that comport with state and federal laws. The goal of the audit/evaluation is to receive recommendations on best practices to help reduce in-custody deaths. Funding of \$250,000 was set aside in an allocated contingency account to pay for this work.

## BACKGROUND

As requested by the Adopted Budget, the Audit Services Division presented a report with a proposed scope of work to be included in a request for proposals (RFP) to the County Board for review and approval in the January 2024 meeting cycle. The County Board adopted File No. 24-113 on February 1, 2024 and the County Executive signed the file on February 8, 2024.

Following a RFP and proposal evaluation process for the external audit of the jail, Creative Corrections, LLC (Creative) received the highest score based on specific criteria stated in the RFP and the decision was made to award the contract to the firm. The Director of Audits submitted an action report to the County Board in the June 2024 meeting cycle for approval to enter into a contract with Creative. The County Board adopted File No. 24-525 on June 20, 2024, and the County Executive signed the file on June 6, 2024. A contract with Creative was subsequently executed.

Creative has completed the first three of the seven phases of its workplan. After completion of its initial review and in-person facility audit and staffing analysis, Creative has issued a comprehensive written report containing its findings and recommendations.

The remaining four phases of Creative's workplan involve confirmation that the Office of the Sheriff has created effective corrective action plans and the audit recommendations have been implemented.

Attached is a copy of the comprehensive written report from Creative.

We request that this item be considered for the ability to adjourn into closed session under the provisions of Section 19.85(1) (g), Wisconsin State Statutes, for the purpose of the Committee receiving oral or written advice from legal counsel concerning strategy to be adopted with respect to pending or possible litigation with regard to the following matter(s). At the conclusion of the closed session, the Committee may reconvene in open session to take whatever actions it may deem necessary.
