SECTION 11 Section 42:02(1)(k) of the General Offinances of Milwaukeeling County is hereby amended as follows:

Administration (SBA) regulations (see 13 GFR 121 402) over the firm's previous three fiscal years in excess of \$22.44 \$4 million, or if the owner(s) of the firm exceed the personal net worth (PNW) described in 49 CFR Part 26.
