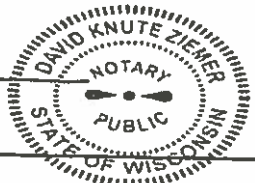

County Ordinance No. 14-8

AN ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 17.10 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended as follows:

17.10. - Advancement within a pay range.

(9) From January 1, 2014, through December 31, 2014, notwithstanding any other provisions of this Code, incumbents of a position not represented by a public safety worker collective bargaining unit who would have received an advance in the pay range upon the meritorious completion of two thousand eighty (2,080) hours, shall be advanced to the next highest rate of pay in the pay range provided for the classification only upon meritorious completion of an additional two thousand eighty (2,080) straight-time hours for full-time positions, and a prorated fraction thereof for employees whose scheduled workweek is less than forty (40) hours or who began employment after January 1, 2014. The intent of this section is to temporarily suspend incremental salary advancements for employees not represented by a public safety worker collective bargaining unit for 2014, consistent with the terms of the 2014 adopted budget.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this resolution and ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
