If this proposal is adopted, Milwaukee County Parks will be authorized to enter into any and all agreements, contracts, amendments, and take all actions required to effectuate the Scopes of Work (SOW) for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for the following projects in the Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern:
 - a. \$475,000 grant agreement for Enhancements to Menomonee River Parkway Sections 5 and 6 Planning and Design.
 - b. \$325,000 grant agreement for Kletzsch Park Wildlife Enhancements Planning and Design.
 - c. \$325,000 grant agreement for Milwaukee County Grounds, Menomonee River Parkway (section 9) and Hoyt Park Wildlife Enhancements Planning and Design.
 - d. \$200,000 grant agreement for Bradford and McKinley Beach Improvements project Planning and Design.
 - B. No direct costs, savings, or anticipated revenues. All work is grant funded. The grants may be executed through multiple contracts, but the aggregate will never exceed the full grant amount.
 - a. The maximum total fee for any agreement stemming from the Enhancements to Menomonee River Parkway grant is \$475,000.
 - b. The maximum total fee for any agreement stemming from the Kletzsch Park Wildlife Enhancements grant is \$325,000.

- c. The maximum total fee for any agreement stemming from the Milwaukee County Grounds, Menomonee River Parkway (section 9) and Hoyt Park Wildlife Enhancements grant is \$325,000.
- d. The maximum total fee for any agreement stemming from the Bradford and McKinley Beach Improvements grant is \$200,000.
