3 From the Interim Director, Office of Strategy, Budget & Performance, Requesting
4 Authorization to Reallocate Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Revenue and
5 Expenses, by recommending adoption of the following:

7 **A RESOLUTION**

9 WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law by
10 President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., on March 11, 2021, to support individuals, families,
11 businesses, and governments impacted by the Coronavirus Disease pandemic; and
12

13 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) received \$183.7 million in ARPA
14 funding, through the ARPA State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF); and
15

16 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board)
17 adopted File No. 21-555: “A resolution to create the ARPA Task Force to review and
18 recommend funding allocations to the County Board for monies received by the County
19 in the Federal ARPA of 2021”; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the County Board approved 73 projects and fully allocated 100
22 percent of ARPA aid, totaling \$183,696,190; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the United States Department of the Treasury (US Treasury)
25 requires the County to fully expend all ARPA funds by December 31, 2026; and
26

27 WHEREAS, as of December 31, 2025, the County has expended
28 \$172,273,557.36, or 94 percent, of its total ARPA allocation, with \$11,422,631.64
29 remaining in encumbrances to be expended; and
30

31 WHEREAS, the County requires that all ARPA projects submit project invoices
32 by November 1, 2026, to ensure all payments are issued by November 30, 2026; and
33

34 WHEREAS, the penalty for not meeting the expenditure requirements would
35 include the return of unexpended funds to the Federal government; and
36

37 WHEREAS, in 2023 and 2024, a reallocation strategy was authorized by the
38 County Board in adopted File Nos. 23-808, 24-535, and 24-753, to transfer tax levy
39 expenditures to Federal ARPA and SLFRF, to ensure the County was fully obligated by
40 the US Treasury deadline; and

42 WHEREAS, utilizing tax levy funding for projects that are not fully spent allows
43 the County flexibility to implement County Board-approved projects as intended while
44 meeting US Treasury expenditure deadlines; and
45

46 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 12, 2026,
47 recommended adoption of File No. 26-333 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,
48

49 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board)
50 hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance (OSBP) and the
51 Office of the Comptroller (the Comptroller) to process administrative appropriation
52 transfer(s) to convert American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and State and Local Fiscal
53 Recovery (SLFRF) revenue and expenses from ARPA SLFRF (operating and capital)
54 projects to tax levy, by reallocating an equal amount of ARPA SLFRF funds to
55 operational expenses that are eligible under the ARPA SLFRF rules, for a net \$0 tax
56 levy impact; and

58 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes OSBP and
59 the Comptroller to process administrative appropriation transfer(s) to reallocate budget
60 authority associated with former ARPA SLFRF-funded projects (operating and capital)
61 to eligible Public Health and Safety operational expenses, and ARPA revenue loss
62 projects as defined by Expenditure Category 6.1, and correspondingly reallocate tax
63 levy funding to the projects from which ARPA funds were removed; and

65 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the
66 administrating department, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), the Office of
67 Corporation Counsel, Risk Management, DAS, Office of Economic Inclusion, DAS, the
68 Comptroller, OSBP, and the Office of the County Executive, to prepare, review,
69 approve, and execute all contracts and other documents, and take all actions as
70 required for the purpose of administering the above-referenced programs funded by the
71 ARPA SLFRF allocation framework.
