 - A. Authorization to enter into an agreement with the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) for Kinnickinnic River watercourse restoration, flood management, and park improvements in Jackson Park. This agreement is for a project that includes removing the concrete channel lining from a segment of the Kinnickinnic River in Jackson Park, restoring the river channel to a more natural environment, creating storage for infrequent severe flooding events in the existing lagoon and certain other park locations, and restoring impacted park areas and improving certain park assets.
 - B. No direct costs, savings, or anticipated revenues in the current year. In future years MMSD will provide Milwaukee County Parks with \$320,000 for access to the park and increased staffing needs. It is expected that the revenue and expense will have a net cost of \$0. Additionally, MMSD will provide \$2,750,000 to the County in an escrow account toward the replacement of the current pool facility with either a new pool, splash pad, or other water amenity under a separate design and construction project. \$20,000 will be provided for lost rental revenue over the course of two years, which has no budget impact because it is replacing rental revenue Parks budgets for on an annual basis.
 - C. No budget impacts in the current year. In future years Parks will receive \$320,000 in total to offset expenses related to additional staffing needs and processing of entry permits. Additionally, a capital project will need to be created for the \$2,750,000 that will be used for the pool or a new amenity. A number of capital

improvements will be made by MMSD to Jackson Park which will allow the county to use capital funds for other issues throughout the park system. Capital improvements include up to \$750,000 on upgrades to the boathouse in Jackson Park, a new in-kind service yard with an additional \$250,000 for additional improvements, a new playground, upgrades to walkways and paths, reconstruction of the KK River Parkway from 47th Street to Forest Home Avenue, a new playground, and more.
