From the Director, Department of Transportation and the Fleet Management Division Recommending the Approval of the Request to Waive Section 9.05(3)(a) to the Milwaukee County Code of Ordinances, and Allow Mr. Darryl Marcoux to Return to Assist With Financial Matters Related to Fleet Management on a Temporary Contract Basis From April 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in early September of 2019, Darryl Marcoux, the Financial Analyst for the Fleet Division, Department of Transportation (DOT), retired with over 15 years of service in the position; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the Financial Analyst position's Job Evaluation Questionnaire, the Compensation Division, Department of Human Resources, determined, and the DOT agreed, that the position should be reclassified to a manager level; and

WHEREAS, being vacant, the DOT had to request an abolishment of the Financial Analyst position, and creation of a Fiscal and Budget Manager position; and

WHEREAS, the position create was approved by the Committee on Personnel and adopted by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in December, and the Committee on Finance and Audit (F&A) approved the request at its January 30, 2020, meeting; and

WHEREAS, the departure of Mr. Marcoux had negative impact on workloads, including a loss of knowledge and deep understanding of Milwaukee County and Fleet Management Division, DOT, processes, systems, and financial matters; and

WHEREAS; the DOT has determined that the best solution is for Mr. Marcoux to return to work on a limited term and temporary contract basis for up to 20 hours per week, from approximately April 1, 2020, through September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on F&A, at its meeting of March 18, 2020, approved File No. 20-215 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Committee on Finance and Audit hereby grants a waiver of Section 9.05(3)(a), Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances, for the Fleet Management Division, Department of Transportation, and is hereby authorized to retain the contract services of Mr. Darryl Marcoux through a temporary agency for a term limited to 20 hours per week from approximately April 1, 2020, through September 30, 2020.
