

Safety and Justice Challenge Community Subgrant Management, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2018, Milwaukee County received a funding award notice for the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase III Implementation and Community Engagement grant in the amount of \$2,300,000; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2019, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted File No. 19-73, which authorized the Chief Judge to accept the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase III Implementation and Community Engagement grant from the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation (#151955) for the Safety and Justice Challenge; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2020, the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation approved a no cost extension through January 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Phase III application included \$180,000 for the awarding of Community Subgrants to local grassroots organizations whose work aligns with the goals of the Safety and Justice Challenge; and

WHEREAS, the Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager will continue to be administratively located at the Wisconsin Policy Forum as part of the Milwaukee Community Justice Council; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 10, 2020, recommended adoption of File No. 20-902 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations, to issue a 12-month contract from January 2021, to December 2021, not-to-exceed \$180,000 with the Greater Milwaukee Foundation for the management of the Community Subgrants.
