





I am writing on behalf of the MICAH Transportation Task Force in support of Supervisor Weishan's resolution opposed to expansion of I-94 between 70th Street and 16th Street and supporting instead an in-kind rehabilitation of the existing interstate footprint, adjusted for safety considerations and coinciding with increased transit funding.

We are opposed to expansion of I-94 because thousands of people will move from Milwaukee County to Waukesha County if I-94 is expanded. This loss of population of people moving from Milwaukee County to Waukesha County is a racial equity issue related to decades of white flight to suburban counties and will increase segregation in the metropolitan region. In addition, expansion of I-94 would worsen global warming, increase air pollution and not fix congestion or safety. We feel that the additional money that would have to be spent to add a lane to I-94 could be better spent repairing streets and for public transportation.

For all these reasons, we are opposed to the expansion of I-94 and support instead an in-kind rehabilitation of the existing interstate footprint adjusted for safety considerations and coinciding with increased transit funding.
