9 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

10 SECTION 1. Section 33.03 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is
11 hereby amended as follows:

13 33.03. – Functions of the personnel review board.

15 The personnel review board shall:

17 ~~(1) Annual review. Annually review the rules, practices and procedures of~~
18 ~~the civil service commission and submit a written report thereon to the~~
19 ~~civil service commission, the county executive and the county board.~~

22 (2) ~~(1) Discipline and discharge.~~ Hear all charges filed by appointing authorities or
23 other persons authorized to file charges under s. 63.10, Wis. Stats., alleging
24 that an officer or employe in the classified service of the county has acted in
25 such a manner as to show that individual to be incompetent to perform his/her
26 duties or to have merited discipline or discharge. Hear all charges filed by the
27 ethics board alleging that an officer or employe of the county has violated
28 chapter 9 of the Code.

30 ~~(2) Rules and regulations.~~ Adopt such rules and regulations as are necessary
31 to properly conduct hearings before the board and to protect an individual's
32 right to due process under the state constitution and the United States
33 Constitution.

35 (4) ~~(3) Meetings.~~ All meetings of the board shall be announced in advance, shall
36 be open to the public subject to the limitations of s. 19.85, Wis. Stats., and
37 minutes of such meetings, except those portions covering hearings on charges
38 against employes, shall be submitted to the director of human resources, the
39 civil service commission, the county executive, chairperson of the county
40 board and chairperson of the committee on personnel within two ~~(2)~~ weeks
41 following the meeting.

43 SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and
44 publication.
