 - A. EMS Division staff have achieved preferred and established upgrades in certification in line with the OEM goal of advancing patient-centered care and education in the county. Promoting providers to practice their increased medical scope of practice to its fullest, approved, progressive extent benefits Milwaukee County and its citizens, equitably and effectively.
 - B. By abolishing the Emergency Medical Technician position, that entire salary amount would be shifted towards this Paramedic and Trainer position with an annual increase of just over \$8,000.00 to support the new position. This increase would be covered and offset by an increased billing rate for the position at special events.
 - C. With 6 pay periods remaining after an effective date of 9/28/2025, the current budget impact would be an increase of just over \$1,900.00. This impact would be covered and offset by an increased billing rate of the position at special events.
