A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, since 1973, the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has entered into professional service agreements with local municipalities for the provision of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in Milwaukee County (the County); and

WHEREAS, the County and local municipalities (the Parties) strengthened their relationship during the Coronavirus Disease pandemic to provide excellent care, coordination, and service to the citizens of the County; and

WHEREAS, there has been a substantial increase in the request for EMS from residents over the past few years, requiring an increase in dedicated oversight to ensure quality and safe patient care; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have embarked on alternative lines of service such as telemedicine and Mobile Integrated Health, to provide access to the right resource to the right patient at the right time, which also requires additional coordination and oversight; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and General Services, at its meeting of January 27, 2026, considered File No. 26-130 for informational purposes only, per Section 59.52(31)(d), Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 29, 2026, recommended adoption of File No. 26-130 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby approves the annual not-to-exceed funding allocations for the agreement, as outlined in the report hereto attached to this file and summarized below:
