

2. **Spot news and series** (shooting of two policemen and resulting confrontations with the black community. My report showed how police responded by rampaging through the black community by beating and abusing black citizens.
3. **Migrant workers of Wisconsin** (film, reports, edit. I took it upon myself to show the plight of the migrant workers. I traveled through the state and lived with the migrant workers for two weeks. This documentary resulted in the Wisconsin legislature drafting laws to protect the migrant workers of Wisconsin)
4. **Black Political** Convention in Gary, IN (attended this convention which resulted in political change for the Black community in Milwaukee and the rest of the country.
5. **BLACK COMMUNITIES** (developed a three-hour film on black housing, migration, settlements and trade skills in the United States, Milwaukee and Wisconsin. This film has been shown on NBC affiliate, WTMJ-TV in Milwaukee, and on public television throughout the state. It is available through the Milwaukee Public Library system.)
6. **BEAT THE HAWK** (a film designated to motivate low-income people to insulate their homes.)
7. **COMMANDOS** (a film profile of a group of young men who were a part of open housing marches during the 1960's in Milwaukee and how that has helped them to help others today)
