6 (ITEM) From the Office of the Sheriff, requesting authorization to apply for and
7 accept a State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation grant in the amount of \$91,327
8 for the 2014 Alcohol Enforcement Program, by recommending adoption of the following:

10 **A RESOLUTION**

12 WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has
13 identified roadway segments patrolled by Milwaukee County as at risk; and

14
15 WHEREAS, based upon this analysis, WisDOT identified those places in Wisconsin
16 with the largest crash frequency due to excessive alcohol use or speed; and

17
18 WHEREAS, WisDOT has awarded the Milwaukee County Sheriff a 2014 Alcohol
19 Enforcement Program grant; and

21 WHEREAS, the grant period is from October 1, 2013, until September 30, 2014,
22 and it is anticipated that there will be 101 mandated deployments and other deployments
23 for a total of 1,632 enforcement hours; and

25 WHEREAS, payment is based on an average overtime/fringe hourly rate of \$53.01
26 per hour and equipment expenditure authority of \$4,815 for seven (7) Personal
27 Breathalyzer Test units and 5,000 Personal Breathalyzer Test tubes; and

29 WHEREAS, the grant requires a local match on salary and equipment expenses of
30 25% or \$22,832, bringing the total project funding to \$114,159; and

32 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its meeting
33 of April 10, 2014, recommended adoption of the Office's request (vote 7-0); and

35 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of April
36 17, 2014, also recommended adoption of the Office's request (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

38 BE IT RESOLVED, the Office of the Sheriff is hereby authorized to apply for and
39 accept a State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation grant in the amount of \$91,327
40 for the 2014 Alcohol Enforcement Program.
