  - A. The City of Wauwatosa and Wisconsin Dept. of Transportation are funding the reconstruction of bridge across Honey Creek, built in 1934 and in poor condition. The reconstruction impacts Parks-owned Honey Creek Parkway. County Parks is seeking authorization to enter into a permanent easement with the City of Wauwatosa for placement of municipal storm sewers, bridge infrastructure, traffic signal and street lighting infrastructure, as part of the reconstruction of the bridge at Wisconsin Avenue over Honey Creek, at the Honey Creek Parkway in the City of Wauwatosa
  - B. The City's \$2.8 Million costs for reconstruction includes \$55,000 for repair of a County-owned outfall, approximately \$60,000 for repair of pedestrian pathways on County land, and as-yet-undetermined expenses for stream habitat and upland habitat restoration on County land. Wauwatosa will also fund reconstruction and future maintenance of a pedestrian pathway that was constructed in the 1940s in Honey Creek that primarily serves St. Jude the Apostle church and school.
  - C. There is no direct County funding, except that staff time is required for reviewing plans and issuing Right of Entry permits.
