 - 87,120 s.f. Native landscaping
 - 20,250 s.f. Porous pavement
 - 7,600 s.f. Bioswale
 - I 52,598 gal. retention capacity
- 2-years to complete after execution
- Educational signage



- 2-years to complete after execution
- 70% of grant funding on-theground work
- Improve Great Lakes basin habitat and water quality
- Recommended metrics
 - Reduction of annual stormwater runoff
 - Impervious pavement
 - Green Infrastructure



- Enhance ecological health of shoreline and coastal areas
- Habitat preservation, restoration, and improvement through stormwater runoff improvement
 - Pollutant reductions in toxins and nutrients (phosphorus)
- On-the-ground work with direct impact

3-YEAR GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE OPERATION & MAINTENANCE

- **3-year \$36,300** plant warranty included within grant agreements for vegetation establishment
 - NFWF \$18,150
 - FFLM \$10,000
 - MMSD \$8,150
- Continuing, War Memorial Center will allocate funds within annual budget to ensure GI is sustained
 - Annual GI maintenance estimated approximately \$5,200
