A. Approval of this contract will authorize the Superintendent of the House of Correction (HOC), beginning on January 1, 2018, to enter into a one year contract with the Benedict Center. This contract will provide re-entry services to female offenders, which includes case management/ re-entry planning and counseling groups such as: Women's Sexuality, Seeking Safety and Life Skills. The Benedict Center will also conduct additional programming that provides Nurturing and Parenting skills as well as evidence based curriculum that are considered key for addressing criminogenic risks and needs: Moving On (Cognitive Behavioral Therapy) and Anger/ Stress.

B. Costs for this program with the Benedict Center is \$198,045 for the one-year period. These funds were already identified for programming expansion in the 2018 budget request.

C. If the Departmental Request is adopted by the Board, there will be no impact to the 2018 budget, since the necessary funds were requested by the department.
