10 AN ORDINANCE

12 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as  
13 follows:

14  
15 **SECTION 1.** Section 42.02(1)(k) of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is  
16 hereby amended as follows:

18 **42.02. - Definitions.**

19 (1) For all projects subject to this chapter funded with federal and county money  
20 and those funded only by county money, the following definitions shall apply;

21  
22 (k) *Small Business Enterprise (SBE)* means an organized, for-profit business  
23 that is independently owned and operated and not dominant in its field. Depending on the  
24 industry, size standard eligibility is based on the average number of employees for the  
25 preceding twelve months or on sales volume average over a three-year period. In no case  
26 will a firm be an eligible SBE in any Federal fiscal year if the firm (including its affiliates)  
27 has had average annual gross receipts, as defined by United States Small Business  
28 Administration (SBA) regulations (see 13 CFR 121.402), over the firm's previous three fiscal  
29 years in excess of ~~\$22.44~~ \$4 million, or if the owner(s) of the firm exceed the personal net  
30 worth (PNW) described in 49 CFR Part 26.

34 **SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
