- A. The District Attorney's Office is requesting to abolish a Fiscal Assistant 2 and Business Development Analyst position to create two new Data Specialist positions. With the continued transition of the DA's office to a paperless office, and with the increase in processing the State's discovery obligations, the Data Specialist roles are needed to maintain and manage the digital discovery system, in addition to our State case management program.
- B. There will be no overall net cost change to the office. Fiscal Assistant 2 is in pay grade NR15 (\$17.69 \$26.54). The Business Development Analyst is in paygrade NR 27 (\$35.60 \$53.40). The new Data Specialists have been placed in pay grade NR26 (\$33.58 50.37). We do not expect this to have an effect on our overall budget.
- C. Due to one eliminated position being in a higher pay range, and one eliminated position being in a lower pay range, the department will take care that there is no net change in costs when filling the Data Specialist positions.
- D. Assumptions include that the currently vacant Fiscal Assistant 2 and Business Development Analyst positions would be filled with a mid-range candidate. The department also assumes that the Data Specialists will start at the lower end of the pay range.
