From the Executive Director of Milwaukee of County Parks, requesting authorization to grant a permanent infrastructure easement to the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) by the Oak Leaf Trail and Edgewood Avenue in the Village of Shorewood, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A REVISED RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) is currently undertaking a project to make improvements to its sewer system in the Village of Shorewood, along Edgewood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, part of the sewer connection, including its associated diversion structures, crosses Milwaukee County parkland; and

WHEREAS, MMSD is offering \$100 for the Permanent Infrastructure Easement of the 0.02 acres of parkland that are impacted; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) has reviewed this project and offer, and recommends approval based on the minimal impact to parkland, the lack of alternative options, and the benefit to the community; and

WHEREAS, DPRC retains the right to require a Right-of-Entry permit for work on parkland; and

WHEREAS, the transaction will be documented with an easement, and the sewer system and surrounding area will be the responsibility of MMSD to maintain; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of June 15, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-496 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture is hereby authorized to prepare, review, approve, execute, record, and/or implement the required documents, or perform actions, required to grant the Permanent Infrastructure Easement to Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) for the construction, operation, and maintenance of its facilities by the Oak Leaf Trail and Edgewood Avenue in the Village of Shorewood; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to execute any required documents to effectuate the approved permanent easement.
